Circles of Support - Youth (COSY)

COSY supports young people aged 8 to 21 in the Sunshine Coast hinterland who are experiencing social, emotional or behavioural difficulties that impact their wellbeing and relationships.

These difficulties may relate to:

- Family relationships
- Health and wellbeing
- Housing and accommodation
- Drug and alcohol use

The **COSY** team provide individualised one-on-one support, brief interventions to address specific needs, and short-term case management and referrals for young people with complex and/or ongoing needs.

The team can also help with advice, information and connection to other community-based services.



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COSY is a voluntary program; we work with young people, on their terms, when they're ready. We take the time to listen and understand and to support and empower young people to identify and achieve their goals.

With support from the **COSY** team, we aim for young people to build the skills to re-engage positively in education, their community and family.
