



Enhanced Carpentry

Launch into a Carpentry Apprenticeship with enhanced knowledge and skills with this PAID Traineeship Program.

Program Overview:

This program is PAID (in accordance with trainee award wages). Participants will be required to commit to full-time 38 hours, five (5) days per week, over 13-weeks, for training and work placement and includes:

- 10-weeks of training to obtain a Certificate I in Construction.
- Teaching elements from 5 accredited units determined as highly desirable by industry (units will be fully completed in Carpentry apprenticeship):
 - Install flooring systems
 - Construct wall frames
 - Erect and dismantle restricted height scaffolding
 - Install exterior cladding
 - Erect roof trusses.
- Industry engagement and additional training in Situational Safety Awareness, Wellness and Self-Care, Industrial Relations and Workplace Preparation.
- 3-weeks work placement with a Construction / Carpentry business.
- Support throughout program to help participants progress and transition into an apprenticeship (subject to availability).
