All children and young people who come to Community Solutions Group have a right to feel and be safe.

We are committed to the safety and well-being of all children and young people accessing our services and the welfare of the children in our care will always be our first priority.

We aim to create a child safe and child friendly environment where all children are valued and feel safe.

We want children to be safe, happy and empowered by supporting and respecting all children, as well as our staff and volunteers.

Our organisation has zero tolerance of child abuse, and all allegations and safety concerns will be treated very seriously and consistently with our robust policies and procedures.

We have legal and ethical obligations to contact authorities when we are worried about a child's safety, which we follow rigorously.

Through this we are committed to preventing child abuse and identifying risks early, and removing and reducing these risks.

This commitment applies to all organisational environments, inclusive of physical and on-line contact outside of the organisations programs and activities.

Our organisation has vigorous human resources and recruitment practices for all staff and volunteers, with a commitment to educating staff and volunteers on child abuse risks.

We support and respect all children, as well as staff and volunteers. Therefore we are committed to the cultural safety of Aboriginal children, the cultural safety of children from culturally and/or linguistically diverse backgrounds, and to providing a safe environment for children with a disability.

We have specific policies and procedures that support our leadership team, staff and volunteers to achieve these commitments.
