Fast-track Your Career with a Certificate I in Engineering

Course overview:

This entry-level course gives you hands-on experience, practical skills, and knowledge to help you gain an Engineering apprenticeship – all while being paid.

In this course, you'll take on seven TAFE-accredited units that are highly desirable by industry, including:

- Develop a career plan for the engineering and manufacturing industry
- Undertake a basic engineering project
- Participate in environmentally sustainable work practices
- Interact with computing technology
- Use engineering workshop machines
- Use electric welding machines
- Use oxy-acetylene and soldering equipment
- Use fabrication equipment
- Pull apart and reassemble engineering mechanisms
- Fusion Welding Proficiency ISO 9606

You will be required to commit to full-time 38 hours, five days per week, over 11-weeks. Which includes 8 weeks of training followed by 2-3 weeks of placement and direct support from our team.

Employment pathways:

- Manufacturing (fabrication, sheet metal, fitting and turner)
- Advanced manufacturing (3D printing, CNC machining)
- Recreational vehicles employment pathways
